Mick-or-Mack History

Mick-or-Mack was started in 1927 as one store in downtown Roanoke. Soon the business grew to several stores, which also included a warehouse in Salem. By the 1950s the business included 15 company store and 35 franchise stores. These franchise stores were in outlying areas, such as Union, WV, Bluefield, Radford, Grundy and including New Castle. The New Castle franchise was opened in the 30s by Tom Foster. Later the franchise was purchased by Oscar Martin, who in turn sold out to Gordon Carper and Hampton Givens in 1954. Gordon bought Hamp's share in 1959 and was the sole proprietor until his death in 1967. Gordon's wife Helen and son Harris ran the business until Helen retired in 1976, selling the business

After several years of success, a new addition was added in 2007. Now the business is run by sons Michael and Richard.

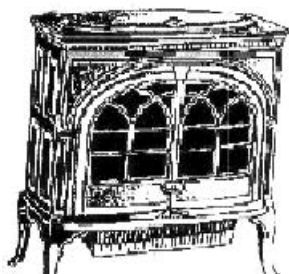

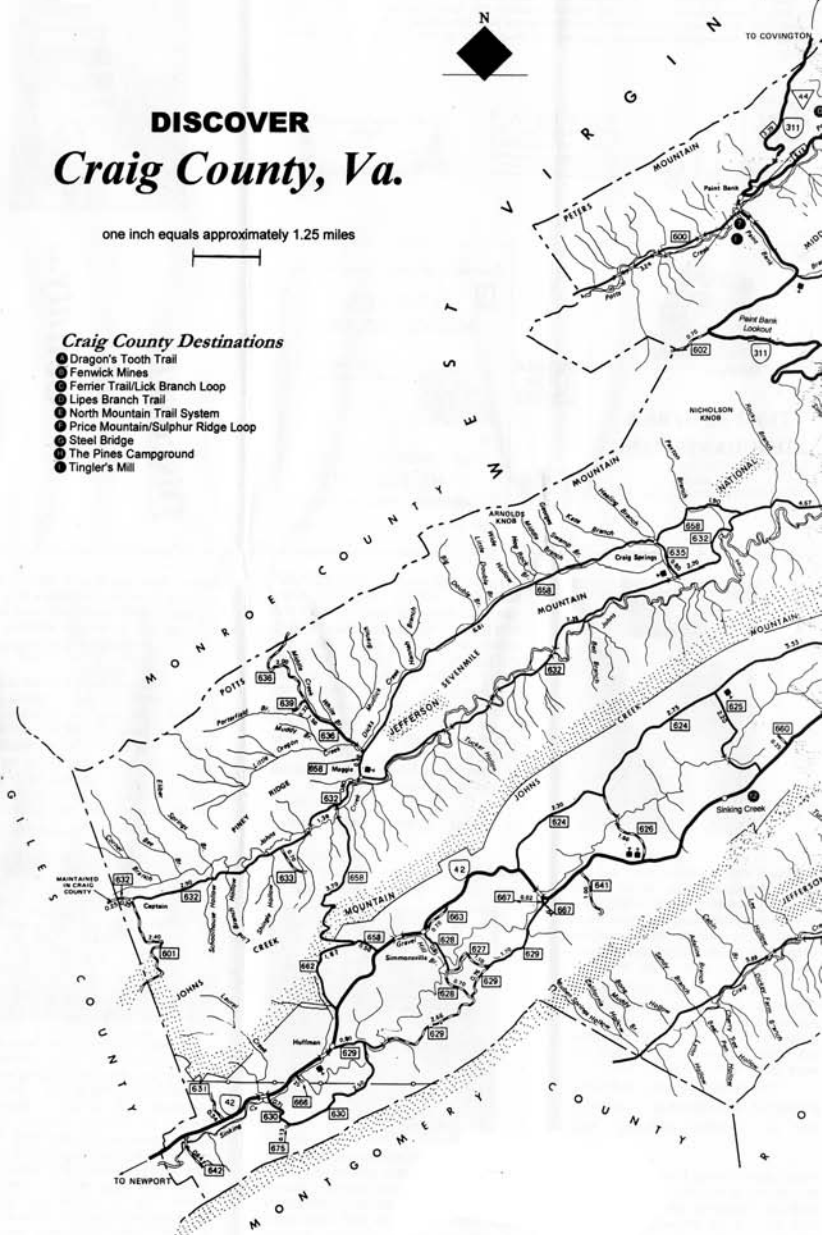

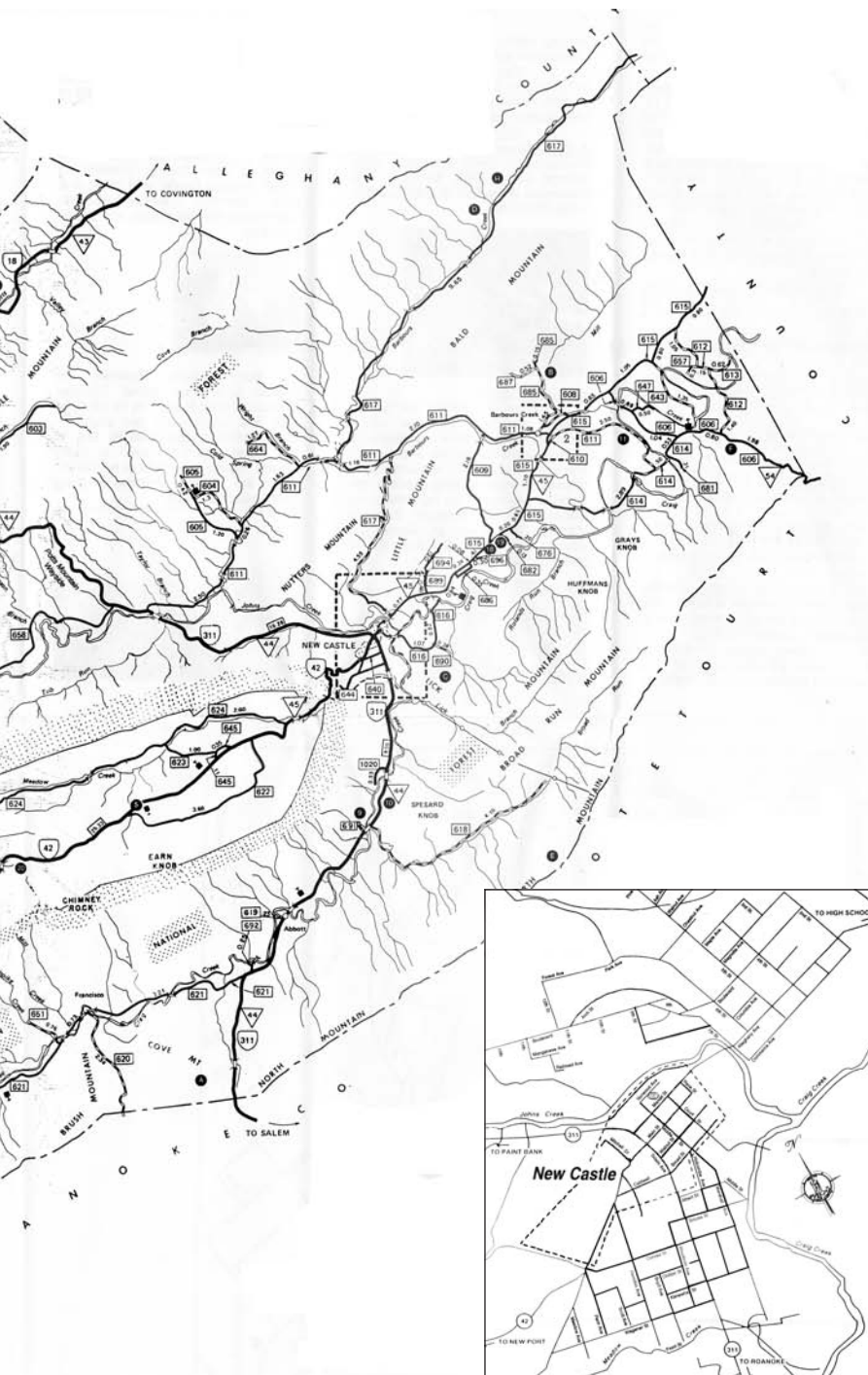

Bus #15 – Kirsten Edwards (Sinking Creek)

Route begins on **Cumberland Gap Rd.** with first pick up at Hedge's at approximately **7:10 a.m.**, next to the (Giles County) line turn around. Returns to **North Mt. Rd.**, next to **Lugar Rd.**, onto **Cumberland Gap Rd.** to a Left on **Bethel Church Rd.** to a Right on **Little Mt. Rd.**, to a Left on **Cumberland Gap Rd.** with a designated stop at **Boyd Ave.** to Left on **Salem Ave.** and proceeds to school

Bus #4 – Suzie Lowman (311/New Castle)

The route begins by leaving the bus garage at **7:45 a.m.** and taking a Right on **Holcombe Ave.** to a Left on **Allen St.**, to turn around and back to Right on **Salem Ave.** to a Left on **Wagner St.**, to the designated stops on the corner of **Wagner St./Woodman**, to **Boyd**, to **Herndon**, to **Scott**, to **Penn** to **Meadow Ave.**, to Right onto **Cumberland Ave.**, then onto **Cumberland Gap Rd.** to Left on **Salem Ave.** to Right **3rd. St.** to Right on **Commerce St.** to Right on **Craig Creek Rd.** Proceed to school.

Bus #17 - Linda Taylor (Upper Craig Creek)

The route begins on **Upper Craig Creek Rd.**, with the first pick up at approximately **7:15 a.m.**, goes to turn around at (G. Hutchinson's), and back to a Right on **Craig Valley Drive**, to the turn around. Back to a Left on **Mountain Breeze Ln.**, to a Left on **Craig Valley Drive**, to a Right on **Broad Run Rd.**, to turn around and back to a Right on **Craig Valley Drive**, picking up everyone on **Craig Valley Drive**. A Right on **Kanawha St.**, to Left on **Holcombe St.** to designated stop. Proceeds to school.

Bus #1 – Diana Smith (Red Brush/Aps Knob/Camp Mitchell)

The bus will make its first pick up on **Barbarous Creek Rd.**, at approximately **7:10 a.m.**, to turn around at (Forest Road) (176), then back to a Right on **Peaceful Valley Rd.** to Right on **Wright's Brush Rd.** back to Right on **Peaceful Valley Rd.**, to designated stop **Sage Brush Rd.**, to Left on **Paint Bank Rd.**, picking up from (Aps Knob) to a Left on **Market St.** to a Left on **Camp Mitchell Rd/Hunter Dr.** Proceeds to school.

Bus #14 - Jim Arthur (Paint Bank)

First pick up at approximately **7:25** on **Potts Creek Rd.**, then to turn around at the county line. Back to Left on **Paint Bank Rd.**, with stops at **Tub Run Rd.** and both sides of **Peters Hill.** Proceeds to school

Bus # 2 - Tammy Dudding (John's Creek)

The route begins at approximately **7:10 a.m.** going down **Dicks Creed Rd.**, to a Right on **Granny's Branch Rd.** to a Right on **Johns Creek Rd.**, to turn around back to Left onto **Dicks Creek Rd.** to designed stop at **Waitville Rd.**, to Right on **Paint Bank Rd.** Proceeds to school.

Bus #16 - Cornette Caldwell (Sinking Creek)

The route begins at **7:05 a.m.** on **Cumberland Gap Rd.**, to a Right on **Happy Hollow Rd.**, to a Right on **Johns Creek Rd.**, back to Left on **Cumberland Gap Rd.** (picking up all children on **Cumberland Gap Rd.**), a Left on **Sugar Maple Rd.**, a Left on **Mill Race Rd.** to turn around and back to a Left on **Cumberland Gap Rd.** To a Right on **Cumberland Ave.** to designated stops on **Conrad/Chilton/Herndon**, and **Conrad/Woodman.** Proceeds to school.

Bus #12 – Lutitia Tuner (Lower Craig Creek)

The first pick up at approximately **7:10 a.m.** on **Howard Hannah Rd.** at turn around. Back to Left on **Craig Creek Rd.**, to a Left on **Caldwell Mt. Rd.**, to the turn around at **Scenic View Ln.** back to a designated stop at **Patton Dr.**, to a Left on **Craig Creek Rd.**, to Right onto **Peaceful Valley Rd.** to turn around at **Fenwick Mine Rd.** back **Peaceful Valley Rd.**, crossing **Craig Creek Rd.**, to Right on **Cedar Rush Rd.**, to turn around at (Graylen Alley's driveway) back to a Left on **Craig Creek Rd.** to a Left on to **Franklin Ln.** to turn around at (Dan McPherson's driveway.), and back to Left on **Craig Creek Rd.** to Left on **Virginia Mineral Spring Rd.** Proceeds to school.

Bus #7 - Dallas Fisher (Cuba/Craig City)

Leaving bus garage at **7:40 a.m.** with a Right on **311**, to a Right on **Court St./Little Cuba Ln.**, to a Right on **Maggie Maw Rd.**, to turn around at End State Maintenance. Back to a Left on **Little Cuba Ln.** to Right on **Salem Ave.** to Left on **6th. St.** to a Left on **7th St.** to a Right on **9th. St.** to a Left on **Boulevard**, to turn around at (Wolfe's Driveway) back to designated stop. Left on **12th St.** to Right on **Park Ave.**, to a Left on **CC Mountain Rd.**, to turn around. Back to Left on **Park Ave.**, to **Craig Creek Rd.** Proceeds to school.

Bus #3 – Carl Bailey (Day Care/Town/Craig City)

First pickup at (Day Care) at **7:45 a.m.** to a Left to **Marshall Ave.**, picking up at designated stops to a Right on **Market St.** to a Left on **5th St.** to top of hill at designated stop/turnaround at **Chest Ave.** Back to a Left on **Magnolia St.** to designate stops to Right on **Boulevard** to Left on **4th. St.** to Left on **Craig Creek Rd.** Proceed to school.
